#### **At-Eez lounge/sleeper chair:**

GlobalCare's At-Eez lounge/sleeper chair is a stylish lounge chair that converts instantly into sleeping accommodation. In its lounge position, At-Eez uses only one-third the space of a daybed and can be moved where needed. In the lounge position, a storage compartment for blankets, sheets and pillows is accessible under the seat cushion. The steel storage drawer is self-draining for ease of cleaning and infection control. A recessed loop pull is located at the top of the chair back for easy conversion into a sleeper.

#### **Headquarters:**

The Global Group Centre, designed by Toronto-based Moriyama & Teshima Architects, won an Honourable Mention in the 2003 Awards of Architectural Excellence competition sponsored by the Ontario Association of Architects. The photos show the south elevation, main entry and pond; southeast elevation at night; and main atrium looking toward the café.

#### **Interlock Series:**

The Interlock Series is a multiple-seating series that connects to form a variety of individual modular and beam grouping configurations. Seating is available in one, two and three seat modules, as well as medium back, high back and bariatric modules. The aluminum leg assembly accommodates front feature strips of wood in several finishes; aluminum in a contrasting colour; or impact-resistant, black moulded plastic. The Perma-Mesh seat suspension provides superior comfort and infection control.

#### **Patient Room Furniture System:**

The Patient Room Furniture System hangs on the wall and installs without the need for structural modifications. By staying off the floor, it makes the room easier to clean and facilitates the movement of equipment. Corners are radiused; handles are generous. The large reveal in drawers and cupboards ventilates the contents; allows staff to make a quick visual check of contents without opening the door; and acts as a handle that unusually tall or short patients, or those with reduced motor skills, can easily open. There are no protruding pulls or knobs to bump into and provide hiding places for dirt. Components attach to a full-width or concealed rail; they can be easily removed and reconfigured.

#### **Tablet dining table:**

The Tablet dining table enables friends to join one another at meals regardless of whether one or more of the group uses a wheelchair. The table top stands an additional 1½ inches taller than the standard 29 inches so that the wheelchair can slide under it. The companion tablet clips on to the edge of the table, extending the top surface and supporting the weight of a food tray.

**York Flexback:**

York Series seating features a flexback design that permits a safe motion-furniture alternative to the popular glider seat on hinged brackets. Glider chairs can injure fingers if a patient reaches for the Kleenex or package of crackers stashed between the cushion and the seat frame. The York Flexback allows the back to “float.” The frame’s spring tension creates the rocking motion while providing comfort and good lumbar support.
